## **Dulles Toll Road lane closures Oct. 15-23**

### **Work to take place near Hunter Mill Road and Wiehle Avenue**

Drivers using the Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) will face daytime single lane closures in both directions starting tomorrow Thursday, Oct. 15 through Friday, Oct. 23 to support construction of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project.

The closures will be in four sections between Wiehle Avenue and Hunter Mill Road along the toll lanes.

This work will be done from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and from 9:30 a.m. to noon on Fridays.

#### **Eastbound Dulles Toll Road Closures**

- Left through lane closed from approximately two-thirds of a mile west of Wiehle Avenue to Wiehle Avenue.
- Right through lane closed from approximately one-half mile east of Wiehle Avenue to just west of the W&OD Trail crossing.
- Right through lane closed for a 200-foot stretch just west of Hunter Mill Road.



#### **Westbound Dulles Toll Road Closures**

- Right through lane closed for about 200 feet east of the Washington and Old Dominion (W&OD) Trail bridge crossing between Hunter Mill Road and Wiehle Avenue.

**Drivers should stay alert and use extreme caution when traveling near work areas during these hours.**
